Liquid Rotenone-Pyrethrin concentrate is a botanical mixture insecticide. The Pyrethrin is an extract from the *Chrysanthemum cinerariaefolium*, which causes rapid debilitation in a wide variety of garden pests, with low toxicity to people, pets, and bees. However, this pesticide is extremely toxic to fish.

The product is combined with Rotenone, which is also a botanical extract from the roots of two related bean family plants. These two extracts are then mixed with piperonyl butoxide, an extract from Brazilian sassafras, which bolsters the effect of the both rotenone and pyrethrin.

This easy-to-mix concentrate is effective on the following insects:

Aphids, whiteflies, mites, ants, lace bugs, elm leaf beetles, Japanese beetles, fruit flies, leafhoppers, thrips, fruitworms, rose chafers, boxelder bugs, sawfly larvae, leaf rollers, stink bugs, harlequin bugs, cucumber beetles, flea beetles, cabbage worms, beet and sod webworms, melon worms, squash vine borers, colorado potato beetles, red-neck borers, vegetable weevils, and more.

Directions for use: Mix 1 to 4 teaspoons per gallon of water. Apply with a sprayer. Be sure to spray the undersides of the leaves and plants you are treating. Repeat the application every 5 to 10 days or sooner after heavy rains as needed. Do not apply this product within one day of harvest. Store the diluted mixture away from light.
