
The Paperpot Transplanter is an ingenious device that allows a single user to transplant an entire 264-cell tray of seedlings in less than a minute under the ideal conditions. The transplanter works in conjunction with special trays and folded paper chain pots to achieve this incredible speed.


To complete the Paperpot Transplanting System, you will need the Paperpot Transplanter, Paperpot Seedling Trays (11¾ inches x 23¾ inches x 1¼ inches), Spreader Bars and Frame, and Paper Chain Pots — available in 2-, 4-, and 6-inch spacings to accommodate the needs of various crops. For added ease of sowing the trays, Paperpot Seeders are an option.

Materials Included:

- A. (1) Paperpot body
- **B.** (1) Transport handle; 2 bolts and nuts attached
- C. (1) Tray platform; 2 carriage bolts and nuts attached
- **D.** (1) Adjustable wheel stem; 2 carriage bolts, nuts, and washers attached
- E. (1) Handle bars
- F. (1) Seedling extractor plate





Additional Materials:

- 13mm wrench
- 20mm wrench
- 4mm Allen Wrench

ASSEMBLY:

1. Attach the transport handle to the Paperpot body with the 2 included bolts, using the 4mm Allen wrench and 10mm wrench.



2. Fasten the tray platform to the body with the 2 carriage bolts provided, using the 13mm wrench.



3. Secure the adjustable wheel stem to the head of the tray platform with the 2 included carriage bolts. Make sure to use the square hole to accept the carriage bolt, with the washers on the opposite side (see inset below).




 Insert the handle bars into the adjustable wheel stem and use the pin to lock it into place. This is easily adjusted in the field to suit different users.



5. To adjust the planting depth you can raise and lower the height adjustment, shown below. To plant deeper, use the lowest setting. To plant shallower, raise the adjustment. Experiment to see what works best for your soil conditions. Remove the latch pin completely to make this adjustment easier.



6. Use the seedling extractor plate to help lift and insert the tray onto the Paperpot Transplanter.
