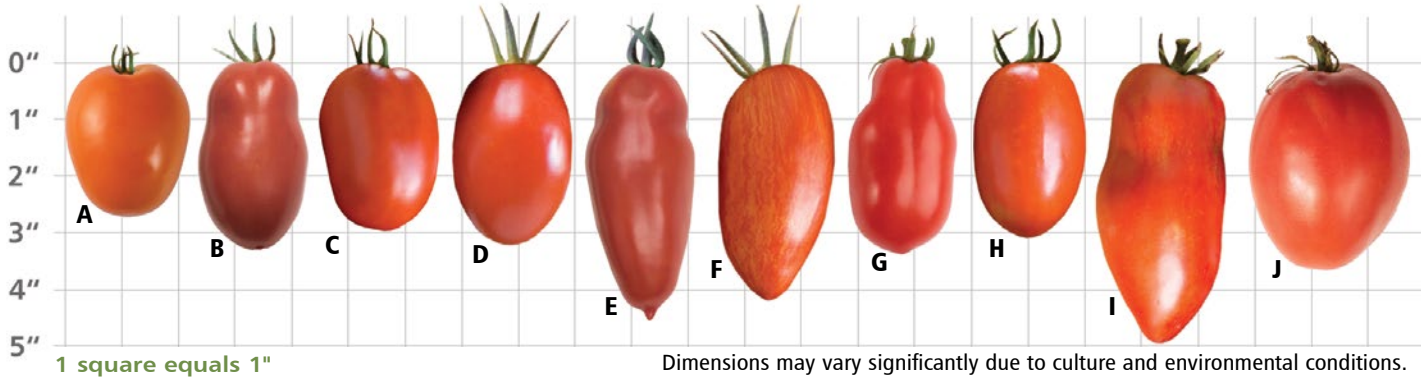


## PASTE, PLUM, AND ROMA TOMATO VARIETIES COMPARISON CHART

<b>Determinate — Bush</b>						
<b>A. Sunrise Sauce (F1)</b>	3376	Roma	57	4–6 oz.	HR: F (1), V.	Much sweeter flavor than others in its class.
<b>B. Paisano (F1)</b>	3849	San Marzano	68	4–5 oz.	–	Good flavor and high solids for sauce or canning.
<b>C. Plum Regal (F1)</b>	2537	Roma	75	4 oz.	HR: F (1, 2), LB, TSWV, V. IR: EB.	Late and early blight resistance.
<b>Indeterminate — Climbing</b>						
<b>Juliet (F1)</b>	707	Midi plum	60	1½–2 oz.	IR: EB, LB.	Late and early blight resistance.
<b>Verona (F1)</b>	3811G <b>OG</b>	Midi plum	67	2 oz.	HR: F (1), V. IR: EB.	Tastier, fuller Juliet type.
<b>D. Granadero (F1)</b>	2584G <b>OG</b>	Roma	75	4–5 oz.	HR: F (1, 2), TOMV, V. IR: N, PM, TSWV.	Organic, broad disease resistance.
<b>E. Tiren (F1)</b>	3998	San Marzano	75	5–6 oz.	HR: F (1), TOMV, V.	Classic San Marzano flavor.
<b>G. San Marzano II</b>	3405G <b>OG</b>	San Marzano	78	4–6 oz.	–	High-quality strain of this classic paste tomato.
<b>Wisconsin 55</b>	3406G <b>OG</b>	Heirloom San Marzano	80	6–8 oz.	–	OP paste tomato with classic old-world look and taste.
<b>J. Cipolla's Pride</b>	4180G <b>OG</b>	Heirloom	82	10–16 oz.	–	Large, refined sauce tomato with great flavor.
<b>I. Blue Beech</b>	3412G <b>OG</b>	Heirloom	82	8–10 oz.	–	Large and meaty "sausage" type heirloom.
<b>H. Amish Paste</b>	3817G <b>OG</b>	Heirloom	85	8–12 oz.	–	Rich flavor, large fruit size.
<b>F. Speckled Roman</b>	3816G <b>OG</b>	San Marzano (striped)	85	6–8 oz.	–	Unique striped skin.
