

# Brussels Sprouts Planting Program

Plant several varieties of Brussels sprouts with different days to maturity at the same time, and harvest in succession. The less cold-hardy varieties are faster-growing, and the more cold-hardy varieties are slower-growing. Each variety will mature in its appropriate seasonal slot from a spring planting. Growers in regions with longer growing seasons can typically make more plantings of varieties with longer days to maturity. Varieties are selected for quick growth so they develop full heads.
