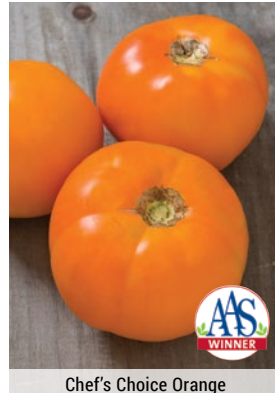
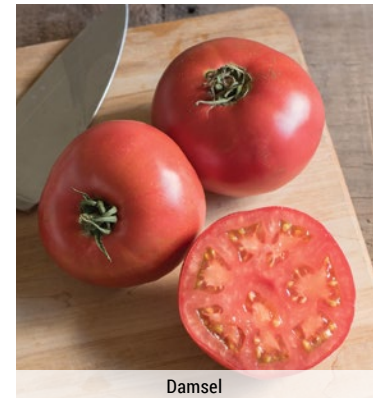

3636G OG	Pink Berkeley Tie Dye	70	8–12	Soft	–	Striking appearance and remarkable flavor.
3774G OG	Damsel	73	8–12	Med. Soft	(HR: LB, N, V)	Late blight resistance and heirloom-quality flavor.
2771	Bolseno	75	7–12	Firm	(HR: F2, TOMV, V)	Excellent flavor and may harvest with green shoulders.
3234	Chef's Choice Orange	75	8–11	Medium	(HR: TMV)	Orange beefsteak with low acid.
3818G OG	Martha Washington	78	8–16	Soft	–	Hybrid of heirloom lines for better vigor.
