



Peat-Free Potting Mix

Peat-Free Potting Mix is a proprietary blend of aged, composted, and/or vermicomposted hardwood bark and cow manure, blended with fertilizer-grade compost, oat hulls, fish meal, and seaweed meal. This nutrient-rich blend is perfect for small seeds, microgreens, greens, and house plants. Meets the National Organic Program rules 205.203(c)(2) and 205.601 and is allowed for use in organic agriculture.

GROWING TIPS

Seed Starting

1. Moisten the mix if it feels dry. It should have enough moisture to hold its shape when squeezed but not so much it releases water.
2. Fill cell flats, pots, or other containers with Peat-Free Potting Mix and gently shake it so the mix settles. Avoid compressing the mix by pressing too firmly.
3. Sow seeds and cover with additional moistened mix or vermiculite, according to growing instructions.
4. Mist with water as needed to keep the surface moist until seedlings emerge. To avoid over watering, water established seedlings only when the mix is almost dry. We recommend a fog nozzle for gentle watering.
5. Peat-Free Potting Mix provides a rich blend of organic compounds that will support seedlings from germination to transplant stage, depending on the crop species and container size. Use a soluble fertilizer as needed when the plant is starting to show signs of nutrient deficiency.

House Plants & Containers

1. Select a correctly sized pot for the species and plant size, with suitable drainage holes at its base.
2. Place a layer of mix in the pot. Avoid compressing the mix by pressing too firmly.
3. Set the plant or bulb in the pot at an appropriate level for its size and species. Work more mix in, around, and above the root ball or bulb. Press to firm.
4. Water thoroughly.
5. Provide newly transplanted plants with a shady location for 2 days, then move to intended location.
6. Water when the soil mix is almost dry.
7. Begin using a soluble fertilizer after 6 to 8 weeks, or as needed.

Living Mix

Peat-Free Potting Mix is an aerobic growing media, rich in beneficial fungi. Growers requiring a strictly sterile mix should heat sterilize before use, which may alter the benefits of the living mix by decreasing microbial activity that may provide nutrients and some natural resistance to plant pathogens.
