

BRUSSELS SPROUTS PLANTING/HARVESTING PROGRAM

Plant several varieties of Brussels sprouts with different days to maturity at the same time, and harvest in succession. The less cold-hardy varieties are faster-growing, and the more cold-hardy varieties are slower-growing. Each matures in its appropriate season from a spring planting. Growers in regions with long growing seasons can typically plant additional successions of Divino, the latest variety.
