Please Read Before Storing Compostable Trellis Clips.

These clips are made from plant starches that have a lower melting point than traditional plastic trellis clips. When the clips are stored in their clear plastic bag in direct sunlight and high temperatures, the bag will experience a greenhouse effect, subjecting the clips to conditions that can exceed their melting point. We have tested the clips and found their melting point to be about 150°F/65°C. Melting has not been observed when the clips are in use on the vine. Temperatures would likely not get that high under normal growing conditions because it would be detrimental and likely fatal to the plants.

We have found Compostable Trellis Clips to be a great addition to our product line, and have been very pleased with their performance at our Albion, Maine Research Farm. We do recommend, however, that you store the clips in a cool, dry, and shaded location — not in direct sun in the greenhouse.
